- Confirmands will eat with entire Youth Group, then participate in worship and the message for the evening with the Youth Group
 - ➤ Dinner, worship and the message will take us to 6:30
- After the message, the Confirmands will go up to Hancock Hall for the evening sessions
- Confirmands will be dismissed from the youth room at 7:30 after the entire youth group joins hands for prayer and the benediction
