### **I. Purpose**

- **To help this Confirmation class confirm their faith in God.**

  - Starting September 8 & ending November 10
- **On Sunday evenings, Encounter runs from 5:45-7:30 p.m.**
- **Here's how this time frame will work for the Confirmands**
  - Wesleyan Youth Choir concludes at 5:45 p.m.
  - Confirmands will eat with entire Youth Group, then participate in worship and the message for the evening with the Youth Group
    - Dinner, worship and the message will take us to 6:30
  - After the message, the Confirmands will go up to Hancock Hall for the evening sessions

- Confirmands will be dismissed from the youth room at 7:30 after the entire youth group joins hands for prayer and the benediction
