In a recent sermon, we were challenged to be REAL Christians, not just respectable ones. On Sunday mornings, we create REAL environments for children in Kindergarten through grade 4 to discover Jesus. We do this by:

Relational learning: Learning together with meaningful relationship-builders.

Experiential learning: Believing experiences are a powerful key to unlocking kids' faith.

Application of learning: Always sharing the connection to our kids' everyday lives.

Learner-based learning: Creating classroom environments around individual learning styles.

TEACHERS

We need teachers that can commit to teach in one of our classrooms for one month. We have four rooms open each month that our groups rotate through each week! You can choose which room you'd like to serve in: art, games, missions, storytelling, drama, movies, or cooking! As a teacher, you get to see all of our elementary children throughout the course of the month you serve.

SHEPHERDS

Our shepherds commit to serve with one group of children for the whole school year, assisting with that class about once every eight weeks. This is an opportunity to get to know children and their families; whether you have children of your own in that group or not, you will both bless and be blessed by them as you join them throughout the year. Many of our shepherds choose to 'move up' with their group over several years, bringing stability and deeper relationships to each group.
