We wanted to share some highlights from the past year. We do not share this to brag, but to express our gratitude and to encourage all to participate in the work of God in the coming year.

Together, we:

- provided Christmas for over 150 children and 13 families
- fed over 320 guests a Christmas meal, providing socks, gloves, or hats
- donated 32 pints of blood to the Red Cross during the Christmas Season
- fed over 1,500 meals through Our Daily Bread

- served 3,902 boxes of food to the community through Mobile Food Pantry
- distributed 1,400 lunches to children in the Athens area through Smart Lunch Smart Kids
- sent 33 people out for three different international mission trips
- served over 2,000 lunches through the Sunday morning Sack Lunch Ministry, including Christmas morning and New Years Day
- assisted with community guests' utility bills in excess of \$10,000 through our Holy Communion altar rail offering and other generous gifts

- Raised over \$7,000 raised for our new foster care ministry through The Children's Consignment Sale
